

and Financial Agreement for NV Elevate Volleyball, LTD.**

for NV Elevate Volleyball 2024-2025 Season.

Player and Parent understand and agree to pay tuition in full as prescribed by Nevada Elevate(NVE) LTD, upon acceptance of their team placement after tryouts to hold their roster spot for the 2024-2025 club season. Player and Parent also understand that payment is **non-refundable**. Player and Parent agree to pay monthly installments each month until their balance is \$0.00 on or before 01/31/2025 or establish payment through a 3rd party vendor so that the player can participate in the 2024-2025 club season. In the event that NV Elevate is ordered by any state or Federal governing bodies to cease any or all practices and you have chosen to use the payment plan, you will not be liable for payments for the duration of that shut down.

Player and Parent understand and agree to pay the total amount per player for team dues according to <https://www.nvelevate.org/>.

Parent and Player understand that there are no refunds of any monies paid once a player accepts a spot on a team for any reason up to and inclusive of injury, mental health, family relocation, dismissal from program due to violation of NV Elevate Policies, JVA Policies, USAV Policies, or AAU Volleyball Policies.

Parent and Player understand that monies paid to NV Elevate LTD. do not guarantee any amount of playing time, positions within a team lineup, leadership roles, or duties.

Player and Parent understand that monies being paid to participate in the 2024-2025 season constitutes a commitment to NV Elevate Volleyball Club as a whole and not one team. In rare events, some players may be moved to other teams for competition purposes. The Parent and Player agree that they are responsible for their signed and agreed upon team fees regardless of the team they compete on for any given event. NV Elevate Volleyball Club will not seek further compensation if a player moves rosters at their discretion, however if the Parent or Player requests a team change that is more than their current fee agreement, they are responsible for the additional fees.

Parent and Player understands that all team fees are to be paid through <https://www.nvelevate.org/> payment plan or 3rd party vendor. Furthermore, Parent and Player agrees that NV Elevate Volleyball Club is providing a service and therefore waives the right to dispute any payment for services made via cash, check, credit, or debit card to NV Elevate Volleyball Club.

Team Rules & Policies Contract

Accepting a position on a NV Elevate team is a commitment by the player and player's parents. Acceptance of the position is a dedicated time commitment regardless of other activities that are occurring during the club volleyball season. Players and parents are aware and agree to the following:

- NV Elevate Volleyball players, parents, and fans all represent NV Elevate Volleyball. It is expected that players, parents, and fans treat fellow teammates, parents, coaches, officials, each other's schools, and communities with respect.
- Bullying in any degree or any form (physical, verbal, written or electronic means) is not tolerated.
- We understand that it is expected to abide by USAV rules, regulations and policies which include the SCVA Participant Code of Conduct, and the USAV Code of Conduct.
 - We are required to complete and submit all forms pertaining to AAU and USAV memberships and list NV Elevate as your assigned club. Instructions can be found on our website nvelevate.org.
 - AAU Membership Card – Number and or copy.
 - USAV Membership Card – Number and or copy.
 - USAV Medical Release Form
 - NV Elevate Contract
 - Team Rules & Policies Contract
 - We understand that all teams have mandatory practices per week as well as a weekly conditioning with Full Circle Weekly except for conflicting competition and/or holiday schedules, etc. at the discretion of NV Elevate.
 - We understand that timely attendance at practices, team conditioning and tournaments is expected. Habitual tardiness or absence, without discussing the situation with the head coach, is unacceptable. And will impact playing time
 - All planned vacations/family events/conflicts scheduled during the season will be given in writing to the head coach as soon as possible.
 - In the event of an illness or emergency, we will contact the coach immediately at the phone number provided.
 - We understand that if a practice must be missed, we can contact our head coach to make arrangements.
 - We understand that each player is afforded the opportunity to play in each tournament. Amount of playing time is not guaranteed and based on merit relative to performance as the coaches have discretion to choose players based on whom they feel afford the team the best opportunity to compete under a given set of circumstances.
 - Extended illness or injuries will require a doctor's note or parental release to resume playing in practices or tournaments.
 - For tournaments, players will arrive 1 hour prior to the start time of the team assignment.
 - Players are not permitted to leave the tournament until all team responsibilities have been satisfied, work, etc. or permitted to leave by the appropriate NVE representative.
 - We understand that NV Elevate T-shirts must be worn for each practice/clinic. All team sponsored gear must be worn at sanctioned events and during travel. Players are to wear warm up gear during non-playing assignments.
 - For practices, players are expected to arrive at the gym with enough time to set up nets/equipment before the designated start time.
 - If an athlete cannot be at practice, the athlete is expected to call the coach with an explanation. It is the athlete's responsibility (not the parent's) to reach the coach before the practice starts. Reaching a coach means just that –**you must make sure that you contact a coach, and they reply to a call, email, or a text.** Do not leave a message and expect that the coach will receive it.
 - Scheduled practice time is start time, not arrival time. Plan on arriving at least 15 minutes prior to the start of each practice.
- ALL technology is prohibited during practice and tournaments. Any equipment that can take pictures is NOT PERMITTED in any bathroom or locker room.
- We understand and will adhere to the 24/48-hour rule. Any player or parent concerned about coaching decisions must wait until 24 hours after the tournament or practice to be communicated and will be considered a closed issue after 48 hours.
 - It is not acceptable for a player or parent to communicate with a coach about playtime **during** the event.
 - All issues must be addressed in the following order:



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- Player/Coach
 - Player/Parent/Directors
 - Player/Parent/Coach/Directors
- Players will be included in every discussion a coach has with a parent. Empowering your daughter to advocate for themselves will help them to become strong young ladies!
- NV Elevate does not provide tape/pre-wrap/etc. used for preventative injuries. Athletic trainers are only available at some (not all) of the tournament sites.

Playing Time

- Playing time for athletes is determined by attendance, attitude, effort, performance, the athlete's potential, the team's needs at the moment, and the team's needs in the future, and is left solely to the discretion of the NV Elevate Coach.
- The "coaching decision" is not up for debate or question. It is the athlete's responsibility to ask what they can improve on in order to earn more playing time. Athletes will be expected to play in any position to benefit team performance.
- While representing NV Elevate, all athletes are expected to behave in a responsible manner. Determination of what is 'responsible' lies solely with NV Elevate'. NV Elevate intends to promote nothing but the highest of standards and a professional image.
- Parent conduct is expected to be positive in every way. Poor conduct, including but not limited to, arguing with, or yelling at referees, yelling at coaches, or saying anything disparaging about NV Elevate players, parents, referees, or any other team, will be subject to being told to leave the venue. If a parent has a question regarding a coach's decision, the parent should wait 24 hours to approach the Director with their player, so long as the player has already attempted to address it directly with the coach, after the match and/or practice and request time to discuss the question. Adherence to the player/parent policies is required.
